If the proficiency sequence is incomplete at time of transfer, students will be required to take the UMSL Foreign Language Placement exam before being permitted to take additional foreign language courses. French, German, Greek and Latin are recommended to satisfy the foreign language requirement.

Student completing a degree from a MO community college that includes a CBHE approved general education core will be allowed transfer credit of more than 64 hours only if the additional lower division credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for upper division courses in the major.
