* Students will be awarded 5 hours of equivalency for UMSL's *BIOL 1811 Introductory Biology: From Molecules to Organisms* **only** if they successfully complete both *BIO 101 General Biology I* and *BIO 103 General Biology Laboratory I*.

** It is recommended by the UMSL College of Education that these courses, or their equivalencies, be completed with a grade of a "C" or better.

+ **Physical Education majors must take *PSY 201 Child Psychology* or *PSY 210 Human Growth & Development*.**

++ Students will be awarded equivalency of the 3 credit hours of UMSL's *TCH ED 3313 Psychology of the Exceptional Child* from SCC's *EDU 250 Education of Exceptional Learners* **only** after they have successfully completed all other UMSL Teacher Education Program (TEP) requirements and are formally admitted to the program.

Education Majors must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA (transfer and UMSL) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

A minimum of 120 hours is required for the Bachelor of Science in Physical Education.

Free Elective hours do not count towards the total required for graduation at the University of Missouri-St. Louis.

Students completing a degree from a Missouri community college that includes a CBHE approved general education core will be allowed transfer credit of more than 64 hours only if the additional lower division credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for upper division courses in the major. **The 39 Hour General Education block of prior to Fall 2002 will not be accepted as meeting MO Gen Ed requirements effective Fall 2008.**

A maximum of 60 hours may transfer without the completion of a degree including a CBHE approved general education core.

To earn an Associate of Arts in Teaching degree, St. Charles Community College students must have a 2.5 GPA and minimum C-BASE exam scores of 235 in each section. Please seek advisement from your St. Charles Community College Academic Advisor for assurance of Associates degree completion.
