* It is recommended by the UMSL College of Education that these courses, or their equivalencies, be completed with a grade of a "C" or better.

** Recommended electives for Associate of Arts in Teaching (8 hour required) are *MAT 201 Structure of Math Systems I*, *EDU 242 Art for Children*, *ANT 102 Introduction to Cultural Anthropology*, or *EDU 250 Education of Exceptional Learners*. **Secondary Education majors must also take *PSY 201 Child Psychology* or *PSY 210 Human Growth & Development*.**

+ Degree candidates must complete 30 to 50 hours of specific subject requirements in one of the following fields: english, foreign language (French or Spanish), mathematics, music, science (biology, chemistry, or physics), or social studies education. The University of Missouri- St. Louis College of Education recommends that you fulfill content area courses with approved electives. These courses should be selected under guidance of an academic advisor.

Education Majors must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA (transfer and UMSL) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.

A minimum of 120 hours is required for the Bachelor of Science in Secondary Education.

Free Elective hours do not count towards the total required for graduation at UMSL.

Students completing a degree from a Missouri community college that includes a CBHE approved general education core will be allowed transfer credit of more than 64 hours only if the additional lower division credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for upper division courses in the major. **The 39 Hour General Education block of prior to Fall 2002 will not be accepted as meeting MO Gen Ed requirements effective Fall 2008.**

A maximum of 60 hours may transfer without the completion of a degree including a CBHE approved general education core.

To earn an Associate of Arts in Teaching degree, St. Charles Community College students must have a 2.5 GPA and minimum C-BASE exam scores of 235 in each section. Please seek advisement from your St. Charles Community College Academic Advisor for assurance of Associates degree completion.
