DEGREE NOTES:

* It is **strongly** recommended that **all** foreign language proficiency courses (12 Hours - Foreign Language 101, 102, and 201) be completed at SLCC or at UMSL (13 Hours - Language 1001, 1002, and 2101). If the proficiency sequence is incomplete at the time of transfer, students will be required to take the UMSL Foreign Language Placement exam before being permitted to take additional foreign language courses.

** Approved Elective courses should always be chosen based on your major and the transfer institution.

A minimum of 120 hours is required for the Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology.

Free Elective hours do not count towards the total required for graduation at the University of Missouri-St. Louis.

Students completing a degree from a Missouri community college that includes a CBHE approved general education core will be allowed transfer credit of more than 64 hours only if the additional lower division credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for upper division courses in the major.

A maximum of 60 hours may transfer without the completion of a degree including a CBHE approved general education core.
