DEGREE NOTES:

*** Effective Fall Semester of 2006: BUS AD 1800 Computers & Information Systems will no longer satisfy the information systems (IS) core competency. BUS AD 1800 will continue to be counted as a lower division business elective applicable to any undergraduate business degree. A new course, BUS AD 2800 Information Concepts & Applications, will now be required. If a student has completed BUS AD 1800 or its transfer equivalency prior to Fall 2006, they will have satisfied the core competency. If BUS AD 1800 or its transfer equivalency has not been completed prior to Fall 2006, the student will be required to take BUS AD 2800.**

** There are five Emphasis Areas in the Business Administration program: Finance, Logistics & Operations Management, Marketing, Management & Organizational Behavior, and International Business. Students must complete 12 to 15 hours in a chosen Emphasis Area.

+ Courses are to be selected in consultation with the student's University of Missouri- St. Louis faculty advisor.

A minimum of 120 hours is required for the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration, 60 of which must be completed at a Four-Year Institution.

Free Elective hours do not count towards the total required for graduation at the University of Missouri-St. Louis.

Students completing a degree from a Missouri community college that includes a CBHE approved general education core will be allowed transfer credit of more than 64 hours only if the additional lower division credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for upper division courses in the major.

A maximum of 60 hours may transfer without the completion of a degree including a CBHE approved general education core.
