\* Recommended electives for Associate of Arts in Teaching (8 hour required) are *SOC 101 Introduction to Sociology*, *GEG 101 Regional Geography: The Western World*, any Anthropology course, and *EDU 219 Education for Exceptional Learners*. Note that *EDU 219* will be accepted as the equivalent course to UMSL's *TCH ED 3313 Learners with Disabilities & Inclusive Education* **only** if the student successfully completes all other UMSL Teacher Education Program (TEP) requirements and are formally admitted to the program. **Only** students who complete the AAT will be awarded this credit.

\*\* Students will be awarded equivalency of the 3 credit hours of UMSL's *TCH ED 3312 Introduction to Early Childhood Education* from SLCC's *EDU 217 Educational Psychology* **only** after they have successfully completed all other UMSL Teacher Education Program (TEP) requirements and are formally admitted to the program.

+ Middle School Education majors must choose a Content Area from the following: Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, or Social Science. The number of course hours necessary for degree completion will vary with each Content Area. These courses should be selected under guidance of an academic advisor.

**Education Majors must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA (transfer and UMSL) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.**

A minimum of 120 hours is required for the Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education.

Free Elective hours do not count towards the total required for graduation at the University of Missouri- St. Louis.

Students completing a degree from a Missouri community college that includes a CBHE approved general education core will be allowed transfer credit of more than 64 hours only if the additional lower division credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for upper division courses in the major.

A maximum of 60 hours may transfer without the completion of a degree including a CBHE approved general education core.
