### **DEGREE NOTES:**

\* Degree candidates must complete 30 to 50 hours of specific subject requirements in one of the following fields: english, foreign language (French or Spanish) mathematics, music, science (biology, chemistry, or physics), or social studies education. The University of Missouri- St. Louis College of Education recommends that you fulfill content area courses with approved electives. These courses should be selected under guidance of an academic advisor.

\*\* St. Louis Community College EDU 215 Principles of Teaching & Learning satisfies University of Missouri- St. Louis TCH ED 3312 Psychology of Teaching & Learning requirement *only* when the student has met all of the other requirements for entrance into the UMSL Teacher Education Program.

**Education Majors must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA (transfer and UMSL) of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.**

A minimum of 124 hours is required for the Bachelor of Science in Secondary Education.

Free Elective hours do not count towards the total required for graduation at the University of Missouri- St. Louis.

Students completing a degree from a Missouri community college that includes a CBHE approved general education core will be allowed transfer credit of more than 64 hours only if the additional lower division credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for upper division courses in the major.

A maximum of 60 hours may transfer without the completion of a degree including a CBHE approved general education core.
