DEGREE NOTES:

* For the purposes of admission into the Social Work Degree program, Students satisfy the University of Missouri- St. Louis Social Work sequence of SOC WK 2000, 2200, and 2201 **if they complete the St. Louis Community College Human Services courses HMS 100, 101, and 102 in sequence, earning at least a B- in 2 of the 3 courses.**

** Courses **must be** chosen from the University of Missouri- St. Louis's approved General Education courses.

*** Acceptable substitutions for this course are SOC 100 Human Relations and HMS 111 Group Practice in Human Services. However, SOC 103 Human Behavior at Work and in Business is the recommended course.

+ Courses are considered Approved Elective, but not for the Bachelor of Social Work Major.

++ Courses are to be selected in consultation with the student's University of Missouri- St. Louis faculty advisor.

All students wishing to major in Social Work are admitted to the University as Pre-Social Work. Students must apply for formal admission to the Social Work program upon completion of related areas and concurrent enrollment in Social Work 3100. **A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 is required for admission to the program.**

A minimum of 120 hours is required for the Bachelor of Social Work.

Free Elective hours do not count towards the total required for graduation at the University of Missouri-St. Louis.

Students completing a degree from a Missouri community college that includes a CBHE approved general education core will be allowed transfer credit of more than 64 hours only if the additional lower division credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for upper division courses in the major.

A maximum of 60 hours may transfer without the completion of a degree including a CBHE approved general education core.

Please seek advisement from your SLCC Academic Advisor for assurance of Associates degree completion.
