* It is **strongly** recommended that **all** foreign language proficiency courses (12 hrs- FL 101, 102, 201) be completed at SWIC or at UMSL. If the proficiency sequence is incomplete at time of transfer, students will be required to take the UMSL Foreign Language Placement exam before being permitted to take additional foreign language courses.

Minimum of 120 hours required for the BA in Anthropology

Students completing an AA/AS degree from SWIC that includes the IAI approved general education core will be allowed transfer credit of more than 64 hours only if the additional lower division credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for upper division courses in the major.

Maximum of 60 hours may transfer without AA/AS degrees
