DEGREE NOTES:

* French, German, or Latin are acceptable foreign languages. It is **strongly** recommended that **all** foreign language proficiency courses (12 hrs- FL 101, 102, 201) be completed at SWIC or at UMSL. If the proficiency sequence is incomplete at time of transfer, students will be required to take the UMSL Foreign Language Placement exam before being permitted to take additional foreign language courses.

There are two degree options for the BA in Philosophy: Option I: BA Philosophy
Option II: Double Major

Minimum of 120 hours required for the BA in Philosophy

Students completing an AA/AS degree from SWIC that includes the IAI approved general education core will be allowed transfer credit of more than 64 hours only if the additional lower division credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for upper division courses in the major.

Maximum of 60 hours may transfer without AA/AS degrees

Please seek advisement from your SWIC Counselor for assurance of completion of the Associate Degree

Students living in the Illinois counties of Madison, Monroe, St. Clair, and Jersey are eligible for the in-state tuition rate.
