Yes, free breakfast and lunch are provided for you during orientation.

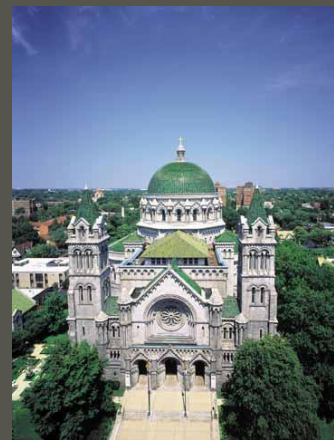
When do I get my student ID card?
