## **Articulation Agreement** Between East Central College And

University of Missouri Board of Curators on Behalf of the University of Missouri- St. Louis

Associate of Arts- Business Administration to BSBA- Business Administration, B.S. Information Systems (BSIS) and B.S. in Accounting (BSA)

This document specifies the terms for a transfer agreement between the University of Missouri-St. Louis (hereinafter referred to as "UMSL") and East Central College (hereinafter referred to as "ECC") and is intended to benefit students at both institutions. This articulation agreement will lead to the awarding of college credit by UMSL for courses successfully completed by students at ECC.

This articulation agreement is intended to prepare ECC students completing the Associate of Arts degree in Business Administration for UMSL BSBA, BSIS or BSA.

ECC and UMSL agree that, in accordance with the current CBHE Credit Transfer Guidelines, students may transfer more than 64 credit hours for lower division courses from either Missouri associate degreegranting or baccalaureate degree-granting institutions. Any additional lower division course credits above 64 credit hours will be accepted in transfer if the credits are applicable to the baccalaureate degree or are prerequisites for an upper division course in the major.

However, please note that students planning to graduate from UMSL College of Business will meet the graduation requirement stating that students must complete at least 60 hours of course credit from a fouryear institution.

To insure the ECC student is ready to enroll in the UMSL junior level business, information systems or accounting courses, the student must follow the recommended plans of study attached.

This agreement would be effective with the 2016-2017 academic year.
