This document specifies the terms for a transfer agreement between the University Of Missouri-St. Louis (herein after referred to as "UMSL") and Lewis & Clark Community College (herein after referred to as "L&C") and is intended to benefit students as both institutions. This articulation agreement will lead to awarding of college credit by UMSL for courses successfully completed by students at L&C.

This articulation agreement is intended to prepare L&C students completing the Associate of Applied Science (A.A.S.) degree in Criminal Justice for the UMSL Bachelor of Science in Criminology and Criminal Justice.

L&C and UMSL agree that to ensure a complete and seamless transfer of credits for A.A.S Criminal Justice, the student must follow the recommended plan of study attached.

UMSL agrees to accept up to 66 hours of credit from L&C from the Associates of Applied Science in Criminal Justice graduate who seeks the Bachelor of Science in Criminology and Criminal Justice.

It should be noted that the A.A.S degree does not complete general education requirements; the student will have more lower level hours to complete when they transfer to UMSL.

This agreement would be effective with the 2017-2018 academic year.




