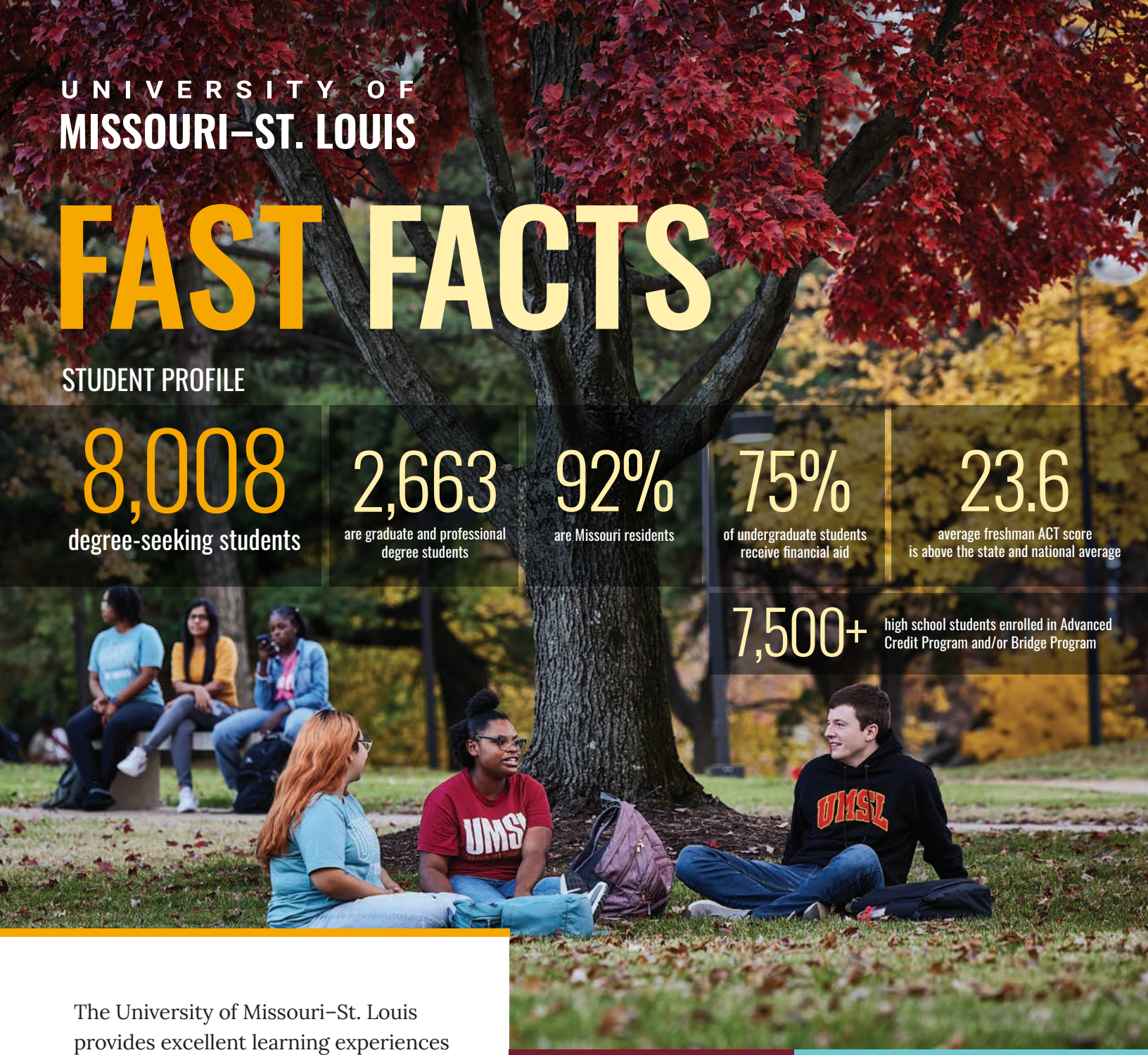

# POINTS OF PRIDE

1. **UMSL is a Tier 1 national research university**, according to U.S. News & World Report – ranked No. 141 among public universities.
2. U.S. News & World Report ranked UMSL No. 84 (No. 1 in Missouri) among the nation’s **“Top 100 Performers for Social Mobility”** ranking – meaning that the university does an outstanding job of graduating students with extreme financial need.
3. **More than 94 percent** of UMSL’s most recent graduates are employed, volunteering or continuing in higher education post-graduation.
4. Military Times has named UMSL to its **“Best for Vets”** list for **nine consecutive years**.
5. Washington Monthly has named UMSL one of America’s **“Best Colleges for Student Voting”** for five years in a row.
6. **UMSL is a seven-time recipient** of the Higher Education Excellence in Diversity Award from INSIGHT into Diversity magazine – the oldest publication specializing in this area.
7. UMSL was ranked **No. 2 in Missouri** by U.S. News and World Report for **“Best Online Bachelor’s Programs.”**
8. U.S. News & World Report ranked UMSL’s graduate program in **criminology and criminal justices as 11th best in the nation**.
9. U.S. News & World Report has ranked UMSL’s **undergraduate international business program** among the **top 25 nationally in 20 of the past 21 years**.
10. UMSL is **one of four universities** in the U.S. to have an Educational Partnership Agreement with the **National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency** to create a geospatial career pipeline.
11. The **College of Business Administration** holds dual AACSB accreditation in business and accounting, **placing it among the top 2% of business schools internationally**.
