Position Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Perform custodial duties to provide for care, cleaning, and routine maintenance of all RWC building spaces including but not limited to restrooms, offices, studios, and lobbies.
- Daily cleaning and stocking of restrooms and custodial closets.
- Sweep, mop, and scrub floor surfaces, vacuum carpets, and operate various cleaning machines.
- Clean and dust walls, windows, and mirrors.
- Empty and clean trash receptacles and recycling bins.
- Work independently while on shift.

Requirements:

- High school diploma or equivalent combination of education and experience
- Must be flexible to meet the needs of various work schedules; early morning, late evening, and weekends.
- While on duty physical exertion could be demanded. While performing duties the employee will frequently be required to stand, kneel, stoop, communicate, reach, pull, push, and manipulate objects.
- The position requires mobility.
- This position requires the ability to interact appropriately with participants, co-workers and members of the University community, and handle any emergency or injury situations which may arise. Individual will work with other student employees in a team environment to provide recreational services to the University community.
- Could be exposed to blood borne pathogens. Must be able to lift 50 lbs.
- Minimum GPA: 2.0
