HOME REPAIR SAMPLING PLAN: NEEDS ASSESSMENT MAIL SURVEY

<u>Overview</u>

This memorandum details the process for drawing a probability sample (n=2,500) representing all City of St. Louis residential households where one or more of the owner-occupants is 60 years or older.

The data set from which the sample is drawn contains one record for each 60-or-older registered voter who has an ownership interest in a one-unit ("single family") or two-unit ("duplex") residence. Each record contains the street address, owner name, and census tract. For units having more than two owners, each owner is listed separately.

The City's census tracts are aggregated into 49 groups and divided into three median household income strata: low (<\$35,000), medium (=>\$35,000 and <\$56,000), and high (=>\$56,000) (see "City of St. Louis Census Tract Groups: Home Repair Needs Assessment Survey"). The sampling fraction will be approximately 125% of the overall fraction for the low stratum, 100% of the overall fraction for the medium stratum, and 75% of the overall fraction for the high stratum. The final sampling share was adjusted for the number of records (25,993) and the survey sample (2,500).

Process

HOMEOWNERS 60 AND OLDER (N=25,993)

Calculate the shares for each income stratum: low (9,142), medium (5,925), and high (10,926).

- 1. Low-income sampling fraction of the overall sampling
 fraction is (0.09618 + 0.024045) or 0.120.
 Number of cases: 9,142 x 0.120 = 1,125.
- 2. Medium income sampling fraction of the overall sampling fraction is 0.09618. Number of cases: 5,925 x 0.09618 = 584.
- 3. High income sampling fraction of the overall sampling fraction is (0.09618 - 0.024045) or 0.072. Number of cases is 10,926 x 0.072 = 791.
