Graduate Certificate in Data Science



The graduate certificate in Data Science is a four-course (12 credit-hours) program. It provides skills, both statistical and computational, and technologies for the growing and popular fields involving data science and analysis. All students must take three required courses and one elective, subject to the graduate school regulations.
