Emphasis Area Requirements

The M.Ed program in Elementary Education with emphasis in early childhood education Early Childhood Education is designed to enable candidates to further their competencies as teachers or program administrators in public and private early childhood programs. The program Early childhood education also prepares them candidates for positions in community agencies that support families and young children. The minimum required and recommended courses are as follows. Students must complete the required Core Competencies and Capstone Course as listed above.

In addition to the Required M.Ed. Core (12 hours), candidates seeking an emphasis in Early Childhood are required to complete the following coursework (18 hours) for a program total of 30 hours.
