### Minor in French, German, Japanese or Spanish

A minor in French, German, Japanese or Spanish requires the completion of four courses in the language beyond the basic foundation sequence (Language 1001, Language 1002, and Language 2101). along with any associated "A" courses for Spanish minors. Transfer students must complete at least two courses for the minor at UMSL. All courses must be passed with a grade of C- or better.

Rationale

- Elimination of Spanish 2172A and 2180A: Grammar content will be integrated into Spanish 2172 and 2180, which will each now be four-credit hour courses. This change will permit a more effective incorporation of grammar into the curriculum. - Elimination of Spanish 2199A: this is to be consistent with the elimination of Spanish 2172A and Spanish 218A (see above). - Minimum total hours will allow flexibility to minors who may choose to take 2199 (3 credits) in combination with 2172 or 2180 (4 credits each) and complete their minor with a total of 13 hours. It may also address the needs of transfer students who may transfer equivalent three-credit-hour 2000-level courses
