Report from the Faculty Senate Committee on Appointments, Tenure and Promotion

January 8, 2008

The Senate Committee on Appointments, Tenure and Promotion met on January 3, 2008 to consider 16 cases as follows:

- 9 cases for tenure and promotion from the rank of Assistant Professor to Associate Professor with tenure (1 of these cases also had the subsequent consideration of promotion to Professor), and
- 7 cases for promotion from the rank of Associate Professor to Professor.

In accordance with the University of Missouri – St. Louis Procedures Concerning Tenure and Promotion (approved by Faculty Senate 2/15/05), the ATP Committee's recommendation for each candidate was forwarded to Chancellor George. A copy of each ATP Committee recommendation was forwarded to Provost Cope, the candidate, and each candidate's Dean, Unit Chair, and Unit Committee Coordinator.

- 2 cases for Curators' Professorships; and
- 2 cases for Curators' Teaching Professors.

The ATP Committee's rank ordered recommendations for the Curators' Professorship and the Curators' Teaching Professor were forwarded to Chancellor George.
