## PROGRAM INFORMATION

### Cost

- Free. However, we ask family members and caregivers to be active partners in this process and to ensure their student attends all of the sessions.

### What

- Approximately twelve (12), one-hour sessions held in the afternoon or evening via ZOOM.

### Instructors

- UMSL Education Faculty and Teachers working on advanced literacy certification or advanced education degrees.

- Sessions begin every August and January.



## BUILDING STRENGTH FOR LITERACY SUCCESS

The UMSL Literacy Clinic provides tutoring to K-12 students who need support in reading, writing, and spelling. Teachers will administer literacy assessments and design personalized sessions that focus on strengthening skills using evidence based approaches to literacy instruction. A case study report will be provided.


Students who are accepted will be matched with an educator for twelve (12), one-on-one or small group literacy sessions, held after school and/or in the evening. Each instructional program is designed with students' cultural, familial, and linguistic resources and strengths in mind.
