
Participant Feedback UMSL Literacy Clinic-Fall 2023


The five participants who answered the survey rated their student's experience as a 5(out of 5) the highest rating.

On a scale of 1 to 5, how would you rate your student's experience in the the Literacy Clinic. 5 responses



All of the participants responded that their student made growth in literacy.60% felt their student made "substantial growth" in literacy, and 40% felt they made "some growth" in literacy. None of the participants felt that their student made "little to no literacy growth".


Please indicate how much growth in reading and writing you noticed from your student. 5 responses


Please indicate how much growth in the enjoyment of literacy you noticed from your student. 5 responses

All of the participants responded that their student grew in confidence with literacy skills, with the majority of participants reporting "substantial growth" in confidence.

100% of the participants reported that they observed the tutoring sessions. The participants also attended every session of the Family Literacy Nights throughout the semester.

Did you observe any of the tutoring sessions? 5 responses






Additional Data

- 100% of the participants that responded to the survey stated that they were interested in enrolling their student for the program in the next session.
- 80% of the participants that responded indicated that their child utilized resources that were provided or suggested from their tutor outside of the tutoring sessions (e.g. Scholastic Pro, literacy websites, selected book titles, and practice materials that were created by the tutor.)
- Only one out of five participants suggested an improvement that the clinic could start at a later time.
- When asked if the participants would like more communications or conferences with their student's tutor, 20% indicated "no", 60% indicated "maybe", and 20% indicated "yes."
- 100% of the participants indicated that they would like more events like the author visit.

100% of the participants responded a (5) on a scale of 1 to 5 regarding the Family Literacy Components of the Literacy Clinic.

What did your student like best about the tutoring sessions?


- The variety of activities
