

# **Graduate Certificate Child and Adolescent Counseling**

## **Program Requirements:**

A minimum of 12 credit hours are required for the degree program.

- Apply knowledge and skills to provide developmentally and culturally responsive counseling for children and adolescents
- Use theoretically based techniques when counseling children and adolescents in various settings
- Analyze factors that influence children and adolescents' academic, career, social, and emotional well-being and success
- Demonstrate strategies to support and advocate for the mental health of children and youth involved in various systems of care, including family, school, and community settings

# **Application Requirements:**

- 1. Online Graduate Application
- 2. Statement of Purpose: A 1-2 page essay explaining your interest in the program and why you are a strong candidate.
- 3. Official transcripts from all universities attended. A Bachelor's degree is required.
- 4. Entrance examinations:
  - a. International Students must document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination. See <u>International Admissions</u> for more information.
- 5. Minimum GPA of 3.0 on 4.0 scale
- 6. Current "good standing" (non-probation) in an UMSL graduate mental health practitioner training program: counseling, social work, or psychology) **OR** all of the following criteria:
  - a. Undergraduate degree with a GPA of 3.0 or better;
  - b. Enrollment in a graduate mental health practitioner or related training program or earned Master's degree in mental health field (or related)
  - c. Letters of Recommendation: 2 letters of recommendation are required from individuals who can evaluate your recent academic performance.
  - d. Two-page personal statement explaining the applicant's personal and professional goals

#### **Application Deadlines:**

Domestic Applicants: Fall - July 1 & Spring - December 1 & Summer - May 1

Applications are processed as they are submitted. However, applications that are not received by the posted date may delay admission until the following semester.

## **Application Fees:**

\$50 for domestic applicants

\$40 for international applicants
