## Master of Education (M.Ed.) Educational Psychology

### Degree Program

A minimum of 30 credit hours is required. All degree options consist of 15 hours of educational and psychological foundations, 9-12 hours of electives or emphasis area courses, and a 3- to 6-hour capstone experience consisting of a field experience, an exit course, or thesis research. The M.Ed. in Educational Psychology is a versatile degree designed to enhance one's current career in an educational or community agency setting or to prepare graduates for the pursuit of another advanced degree

### Application Requirements

1. Graduate School Application
  - a. <http://umsl.edu/go/Apply-Now>
2. Official transcripts from all universities attended
  - a. Earned baccalaureate degree from an accredited college or university with a 3.0 overall GPA.
  - b. Applicants with GPA's below 3.0 may be considered for restricted admission, which requires completion of 12 graduate semester hours with a 3.0 graduate GPA to continue in the program.
3. Letters of Recommendation
  - a. Submit two letters of recommendation with the online Graduate Application
4. Entrance Examinations
  - a. There are no entrance exams for domestic students.
  - b. International students are required to document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination before a decision is made on admission.
5. Supplemental Materials – upload directly into the application:
  - a. A written statement describing your professional goals
  - b. Additional materials (e.g. curriculum vita, publications, etc.)

### **Application Deadlines (for domestic applicants)**

**Fall semester:** July 1

**Spring semester:** December 1

**Summer session:** May 1

### **Application Deadline (for international applicants)**

**Fall semester:** May 1

**Spring Semester:** October 1

### **Application Fee**

\$50 for domestic applicants; \$40 for international applicants

### **Assistantships and Fellowships**

Assistantships typically are awarded only to doctoral students.
