

## Graduate Certificate History Education

### **Degree Program:**

- A minimum of 18 credit hours of graduate-level courses with a minimum 3.0 GPA in the program.
- The certificate is designed for practicing teachers, instructional coordinators, and history educators who are seeking to deepen their knowledge of history education.

### **Entrance Requirements:**

1. Application
  - a. <http://umsl.edu/go/Apply-Now>
2. Three Letters of Recommendation
3. Writing Sample
4. Transcript (s) and Entrance examination(s)
  - a. An official BA or Master's transcript must be submitted.
  - b. International applicants are required to document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination before a decision is made on admission.
5. Grade Point Average
  - a. Minimum of 3.2 on 4.0 scale.

### **Application Deadline: [domestic students]**

**Fall:** July 1

**Spring:** December 1

**Summer:** May 1

*Applications are processed as they are submitted. However, applications that are received after the posted date may delay admission until the following semester.*
