Application Requirements

1. Graduate School Application <http://umsl.edu/go/Apply-Now>
2. Three Letters of Recommendation (submitted via online application)
3. Writing Sample (upload directly into online application)
4. Updated Resume/CV (upload directly into online application)
5. Supplemental Application (complete and upload directly into online application)

6. Transcript(s) and Entrance examination(s)
 - a. An official BA or Master's transcript must be submitted.
 - b. International students are required to document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination before a decision is made on admission.
7. Grade Point Average
 - a. Minimum of 3.2 on 4.0 scale.

Application Deadline

Applications are processed as they are submitted. However, applications that are received after the posted date may delay admission until the following semester.

- Fall term – March 15th
- Spring term – October 15 (limited admissions)
