Program Requirements:

A minimum of 34 credit hours are required for the degree program.

Application Requirements:

- 1. Online Graduate Application
- 2. Statement of Purpose: A 1-2 page essay explaining your interest in the program and why you are a strong candidate.
- 3. Official transcripts from all universities attended.
- 4. Entrance examinations:
 - a. International Students must document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination. See International Admissions for more information.

5. Minimum GPA

a. Minimum of 2.75 on 4.0 scale in undergraduate categories and 3.00 in graduate work.

Application Deadlines:

Domestic Applicants: Fall - June 1

International Applicants: Fall - May 1

To be considered for a Graduate Assistant Scholarship (Domestic and International): Jan. 1

Applications are processed as they are submitted. However, applications that are not received by the posted date may be delayed admission until the following term.
