

Graduate Certificate Artificial Intelligence

Certificate Program:

- The graduate certificate in Artificial Intelligence is a four-course program.
- It provides skills and training necessary to start and/or advance in the growing areas of AI, with a range of electives to focus more specifically in one's desired direction of study.
- All students must take two required courses and two electives.
- Prior background in AI is not required to enter this program.

Application Requirements:

- 1. Application
 - a. http://umsl.edu/go/Apply-Now
- 2. Bachelor's Degree
 - a. By the time of enrollment, prospective students must have obtained a baccalaureate degree or the equivalent from an accredited college or university.
- 3. Grade Point Average (GPA) and coursework
 - a. A minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale is required to be considered for regular admission.
 - b. A prior GPA below 3.0 will be considered on an individual basis for restricted admission.
 - c. Applicants must demonstrate proficiency in programming with data structures, object-orientation, design and analysis of algorithms, as well as minimum of basic calculus and statistics.
- 4. Official Transcripts
 - a. Applicants must submit official transcripts to the Graduate Admissions Office documenting the baccalaureate degree and all other prior college and graduate-level coursework completed.

Application Deadline

Fall admission: July 1

Spring admission: December 1 Summer admission: May 1

Applications submitted after the deadlines will be considered for admissions on a rolling basis until the beginning of the semester.

\$50 for domestic applicants; \$40 for international applicants
