

Graduate Certificate Bioethics

Program Requirements:

A minimum of 12 credit hours are required for the degree program.

- The Graduate Certificate in Bioethics blends the mission and values of philosophy, the medical field and social work for equitable service provision, knowledgeable development of ethical policies and just professional decision making at the institutional, local, or state level.
- This program provides an interdisciplinary exploration of bioethical issues that arise in health care, biological sciences and emerging technologies. It is most applicable to students with interests in nursing, social work, law, public policy, public health, philosophy, theology, and optometry.

Application Requirements:

- 1. Online Graduate Application
- 2. Statement of Purpose: A 1-2 page essay explaining your interest in the program and why you are a strong candidate.
- 3. Official transcripts from all universities attended. A Bachelor's degree is required.
- 4. Entrance examinations:
 - a. International Students must document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination. See <u>International Admissions</u> for more information.
- 5. Minimum GPA of 3.0 on 4.0 scale
- 6. Letters of Recommendation: 2 letters of recommendation are required from individuals who can evaluate your recent academic performance.

Application Deadlines:

Domestic Applicants: Fall - July 1 \diamond Spring - December 1 \diamond Summer - May 1 Applications are processed as they are submitted. However, applications that are not received by the posted date may delay admission until the follow semester.
