

## Graduate Certificate Character and Citizenship Education

### Degree Program

- A minimum of 18 credit hours of graduate course work is required for this certificate. Twelve of these hours must consist of the four core courses in character and citizenship education. A minimum of six additional hours are to be chosen from the list of electives.
- At least twelve hours must be completed in residence at UMSL

### Application Requirements

1. Graduate School Application
  - a. <http://umsl.edu/go/Apply-Now>
2. Official transcripts from all universities attended
  - a. Applicants must have an undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale
3. Two Letters of Recommendation
  - a. At least one of the two required letters must be from a current or former college-level instructor
4. Personal Statement
  - a. A two-page personal statement explaining the applicant's personal and professional goals

### Application Deadlines

Applications are processed as they are submitted. However, applications that are not received by the posted date may delay admission until the following term.

- Fall term - July 1
- Spring term - December 1
- Summer term - May 1
