

# Graduate Certificate Character and Citizenship Education

#### **Degree Program**

- A minimum of 18 credit hours of graduate course work is required for this certificate. Twelve of these hours must consist
  of the four core courses in character and citizenship education. A minimum of six additional hours are to be chosen from
  the list of electives.
- At least twelve hours must be completed in residence at UMSL

## **Application Requirements**

- 1. Graduate School Application
  - a. http://umsl.edu/go/Apply-Now
- 2. Official transcripts from all universities attended
  - a. Applicants must have an undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale
- 3. Two Letters of Recommendation
  - a. At least one of the two required letters must be from a current or former college-level instructor
- 4. Personal Statement
  - a. A two-page personal statement explaining the applicant's personal and professional goals

### **Application Deadlines**

Applications are processed as they are submitted. However, applications that are not received by the posted date may delay admission until the following term.

- Fall term July 1
- Spring term December 1
- Summer term May 1

#### **Application Fee**

\$50 for domestic applicants; \$40 for international applicants
