# **Application Requirements**

- 1. Graduate School Application
  - a. <a href="http://umsl.edu/go/Apply-Now">http://umsl.edu/go/Apply-Now</a>
- 2. Bachelor's Degree
  - a. By the time of enrollment, prospective students must have obtained a baccalaureate degree or the equivalent from an accredited college or university.
- 3. Grade Point Average (GPA) and coursework
  - a. A minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale is required to be considered for regular admission.
  - b. An undergraduate GPA below 3.0 will be considered on an individual basis for restricted admission.
  - c. Applicants must demonstrate proficiency with Java programming and either basic networking or basic cybersecurity
- 4. Official Transcripts
  - a. Applicants must submit official transcripts to the Graduate Admissions Office documenting the baccalaureate degree and all other prior college and graduate-level coursework completed.

#### **Application Deadline**

Applications submitted after the deadlines will be considered for admissions on a rolling basis until the beginning of the semester.

Fall admission: July 1

Spring admission: December 1 Summer admission: May 1
