

# Master of Education Elementary Education

#### **Degree Program**

A minimum of 30 credit hours is required. All program plans consist of:

- 1. 12 hours of core.
- 2. Elementary Education concentration opportunity to develop an area of specialization
- 3. a capstone or internship
  - a. The M.Ed. capstone project is a teacher action research project that is presented in a poster session at the conclusion of the semester.

#### **Application Requirements**

- 1. Application http://umsl.edu/go/Apply-Now
- 2. Official transcripts from all universities attended
  - a. Successful applicants must have completed a baccalaureate degree in education before beginning the master's program.
- 3. Grade Point Average
  - a. Minimum of 3.0 on 4.0 scale
  - b. Students whose total undergraduate GPA and major GPA are between 2.75 and 2.99 may be admitted on a restricted basis except in the following circumstances:
    - i. Admission requires GPAs of 2.75 or better in
      - 1. a) the undergraduate major field,
      - 2. b) education coursework, and
      - 3. c) overall.
    - ii. Students with GPAs below 2.75 may submit "supportive evidence" and letters of recommendation. Students entering with GPAs below 2.75 are admitted on restricted status and required to obtain a 3.0 graduate GPA in their first 9 graduate hours.
- 4. Entrance examinations
  - a. There are no entrance exams for domestic students.
  - b. International students are required to document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination before a decision is made on admission.
- 5. Letters of recommendation
  - a. May be invited for applicants who do not meet the normal criteria for admission.

## <u>Application Deadline (for international applicants)</u>

Fall semester: May 1 Spring semester: October 1

**Application Fee** 

\$50 for domestic applicants; \$40 for international applicants
