St. Louis County residents:

If you are 19 years or younger, you can receive free counseling, evaluation and psychiatric services from St. Louis Counseling, Jewish Family and Children's Services, Lutheran Family and Children's Services, Safe Connections and Provident Behavioral Health.

Community Psychological Services (CPS)

232 Stadler Hall, UMSL

- Sliding scale fee: student max \$25 but usually less, rare cases to \$0/community \$16-\$125 •
- Clinicians are often doctoral students in the clinical psychology program at UMSL
- Often waitlist (recently 2 months), individual therapy only, no acute clients
- Rolling admission DBT group, must be in individual therapy, ext.8390 for group intake

*<u>Jewish Family and C</u>hildren's Services 🔍 🕈 🗣 🍆

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10950 Schuetz Rd (near Lindbergh Blvd)

- Sliding scale fee: very low-\$110 & most insurances (no Medicaid)
- Some clinicians offer individual DBT and EMDR treatment. No primary eating or substance disorders.
- Other services: Mental health case management, financial assistance, pantry

*Walter's Walk

737 Dunn Rd., Hazelwood

- Sliding scale fee: \$0 and up & most insurances (no one turned away for inability to pay)
- Offers holistic services: Massage, Yoga, Tai Chi, Reiki and essential oil workshops •
- Clinician specialties: many EMDR trained, individual DBT, personality disorders, substance & eating disorders, developmental disabilities (one clinician), generalists.

*St. Louis Counseling

(formerly Catholic Family Services)

5 St. Louis locations (St. Louis, Florissant, West County, Bellefontaine, Herculaneum)

Sliding scale fee: \$20-30 & most insurances (no Medicaid) •

- Appointment within 2 weeks
- Generalist practitioners no eating or substance disorders or severe mental illness, Veteran counseling, Trauma Informed-CBT, Parent skills group
- Waitlist for one psychiatrist Self-pay or through insurance (no Medicaid). No adult ADHD meds.
- Interpreters hired as needed ٠

- Sliding scale fee: \$30 and up & most insurances, Medicaid but no MO Healthnet over age 20
- Most issues treated, trauma therapists, survivors of suicide group, male perpetrators DV group •


