ABSTRACT: Collection of original drawings for Weatherbird cartoons and other editorial

and advertising cartoons produced for the St. Louis Post-Dispatch newspaper.

**EXTENT:** Approximately 24 linear feet

**LANGUAGE**: English

**SCOPE:** This collection is comprised of original Weatherbird drawings, drawings on other editorial and political subjects by Weatherbird artists, and archival materials.

**HISTORICAL NOTE:** The Weatherbird cartoon began in 1901 and is the longest continuous daily cartoon in American journalism. Early cartoons only commented on the weather, but over time the drawing and title commented on local and national current events.

ACCESS: This collection is available for on-site use only in the Rare Book and Manuscripts Reading Room. Some of the material may be photocopied, digitally scanned or photographed, subject to condition and other access restrictions. The St. Louis Mercantile Library is located on levels one and two of the Thomas Jefferson Library building on the University of Missouri-St. Louis' north campus.
