Lewis and Clark Card Games

Set-up:

Print out these cards. You might want to print them onto colored card-stock or heavy-duty paper.

Cut along the lines to make 32 cards.

You might want to glue the cards to old playing cards or have them laminated for long-term use.

You are now ready to play. There are two games you can play. You might be able to come up with more.

REMEMBER (MemoryTM)

Turn the cards face down

Mix them up

Divide them (face down) into a grid

Take turns with a friend turning two cards face up.

If they match, place the pair of cards in front of you, and go again.

If they don't, turn them face down again, and it's the next player's turn.

The person with the most pairs when all the cards have been collected, wins.

COMPASS POINT (Old Maid)

Remove one "Compass Point" card from the deck

Shuffle the cards

Deal the cards out to the players until all cards have been dealt

The youngest player goes first

Players take turns drawing a card from another player's hand

If the drawn card matches one in your hand, place the pair of cards in front of you, and go again.

If they don't, put the new card in your hand, and it's the next player's turn.


The player who ends up with the "Compass Point" after all the pairs have been made loses.




