<b>Abstract</b>	The collection contains the financial and legal papers of the Illinois Glass Company initially owned by the Levis and Smith families of Alton, Illinois. The material includes a large collection of stock certificates, financial record books, legal trusts, legal agreements, tax papers, and business related correspondence from within the company dating from its founding in the early 1870's until it merged with the Owens Bottle Company and became the Owens-Illinois Glass Company in the early 1930's.

## Biographical/Historical note

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The Illinois Glass Company, located in Alton, Illinois, was purchased in 1873 by Edward Levis and William Eliot Smith. Together their partnership was able to produce a successful business in the manufacturing of glass bottles and helped to create a major source of industry for the town of Alton, Illinois. In 1903 Edward Levis died and in 1909, the sons of Edward Levis took control of the company after the death of co-founder William Eliot Smith. Around 1910, the Illinois Glass Company began to incorporate the use of automatic bottle machines in their Alton, Illinois factory, which were purchased from the Owens Bottle Company. More automated machines were added to the Alton, Illinois plant and the Illinois Glass Company continued to expand and profit. Similarly, the Owens Bottle Company was also expanding, as it held the rights to the patent of the automatic bottle machine. Looking to expand further, the Owens Bottle Company began to realize the growth and strength of the Illinois Glass Company and after several years of meetings, the companies merged in 1929 to form the Owens-Illinois Glass Company. The new company was headquartered in Toledo, Ohio and by 1930 William E. Levis, the grandson of the Illinois Glass Company co-founder Edward Levis, was president. The Owens-Illinois Glass Company would continue to expand and in 1954 the company changed its name to Owens-Illinois, Inc. The company would eventually change its trade name to O-I as its international operations expanded. In 2011 Owens-Illinois, Incorporated was listed as a Fortune 500 Company.
