

M-252: Ernst Connolly Collection Finding Aid

HISTORY: This collection was donated to the St. Louis Mercantile Library in 2001. A Texas native, Dr. Connolly began his career as a faculty member at Miami University, Oxford, Ohio, in 1952. He moved to St. Louis in 1955, where he taught at Washington University; he joined the faculty at the University of Illinois Urbana-Champaign in 1957.

While a professor at Illinois, he was tapped to be an Assistant Director of the National Park Service. He came to Washington in 1967, and retired as Chief Appeals Officer of the Park Service in 1992.

During Ernest Connolly's tenure with the Park Service, internal reorganizations during the Carter administration resulted in the creation of the Heritage Conservation and Recreation Service, of which Dr. Connolly served as Associate director from 1978 to 1979.

The bulk of the Connolly collection resides at the National Trust for Historic Preservation Library at the University of Maryland.

SCOPE: Boxes One and Two of this collection consist of records, clippings, correspondence, and research related to historic preservation and tourism of Ste. Genevieve, Missouri.

Box Three contains architectural drawings of historic homes in Ste. Genevieve, Missouri, dated from the 1930s and 1950s.
