For Advanced Placement (AP) credit, you must contact College Board to have your official AP transcripts sent to UMSL. Electronic transcripts are accepted through Parchment, National Clearinghouse, or eScript-Safe. Failure to submit your final transcript(s) will prevent you from registering for future semester at UMSL.
