**Collaborative Psychology Degree Program**  
Students with catalog years beginning Fall 2022 or after

- Students must complete a minimum of 30 hours of psychology coursework.
- A maximum of 50 hours of psychology coursework will count toward graduation requirements.
- Students must maintain 51% or more credit hours in online courses.
- Students must complete all degree, college, and university graduation requirements of their primary institution, including UMSL's Math Proficiency Requirement and the Foreign Language Requirement.
- All coursework must be completed at a C- or above; Students must earn a 2.0 within the major.
- At least 12 credit hours of the distribution requirements and electives must be at the 3000-4000 level.
