

## Tax Season Is Here! As we all know, tax season is upon us! Do you know of someone

who needs help with taxes? Here are a couple of resources.

The St. Louis Tax Assistance Programs offers free income tax

return preparation and tax information for families with income under \$54,000. On both February 17 and 24, you can find tax

You will need to bring: all w-2's, copy of 2016 tax return, copy of your check for direct deposit, valid picture identification (driver's license or passport), social security card, proof of your child care expenses, Forms 1095A, 1095B, or 1095C. If filing a joint return, both spouses must be present. The UMSL Voluntary Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program also

provides free tax preparation for low income, disabled, and elderly members in our community. IRS-certified volunteers provide free basic income tax return preparation with electronic filing to qualified individuals. UMSL VITA, sponsored by the Gamma Psi Chapter of Beta Alpha Psi, UMSL's Department of Accounting, GECC Tax Coalition and the IRS, has been offering this service now for 45 years! Business students volunteer by preparing federal and state income tax returns at one of five locations in the St. Louis metropolitan area. 
