million! That's what we recently learned after the University of Missouri System conducted an economic impact analysis for all of the campuses. Overall, the University of Missouri System found they have a \$5.4 billion impact on the state of Missouri.

As I have noted before, UMSL is committed to our mission as an Anchor Institution in the region and to increasingly leverage our economic impact for local communities. In the past year for example, we have built business relationships with local landscape

companies and are looking to connect with more businesses. We
