On February 21<sup>st</sup>, Members of the Association and their guests had a "behind the scenes" tour of the Missouri History Museum's award winning exhibition "#1 in Civil Rights: the African-American Struggle for Freedom in St. Louis." The exhibition concluded in April and set attendance records. Our group was taken through the exhibition by Gwen Moore, Curator. In addition to discussing various parts of the

exhibition, she described the selection process as well as some of the exhibits that had to be excluded because of space restrictions.

#### FOUR CAMPUS RETIREES ASSOCIATION MEETING

Representatives of Retirees Association from all four campuses met in Columbia on May 4. The first part of the meeting gave each of us an opportunities to describe activities we support, as well as a look at how some could be adapted for use by other Associations.

President Choi then gave a summary of the current state of the university. He was asked about the use of the term "flagship campus" by some administrators. He replied that most states have a campus that is referred to as the "flagship campus." He is not pursuing what he calls "the flagship model". Instead, his planning is based on the "One University Concept". An important aspect of that are "Centers of Excellence" which involves development by all four campuses. There is a system taskforce to define and implement the "One University."

He predicted that over the next five years, the University system can expect continuing cuts from the state appropriations.

After the question and answer session with President Choi, there were presentations by Marsha Fischer, Chief Human Resolutes Officer and Associate Vice President of Human Resolutes, and Vice President, Ryan Rapp. The former dicussed various benefits issues, including health plans. The latter gave a detailed presentation about the final status of the University.

A final version of the minutes for this meeting will be distributed to members. UMSL RA attendees at the meeting were Debbie Kettler, Joe Martinich, Hal Harris, Clark Hickman, and Chuck Korr.
