Alan J. Kuperman is an Associate Professor at the LBJ School of Public Affairs, University of Texas at Austin, where he is also Coordinator of the Nuclear Proliferation Prevention Project (NPPP.org). His work has been published in *Foreign Affairs*, the *Bulletin of the Atomic Scientists*, and *The New York Times*. His most recent book is *Nuclear Terrorism and Global Security: The Challenge of Phasing out Highly Enriched Uranium* (New York: Routledge, 2014). As a staffer in the U.S. Congress, he drafted the provision of the 1992 Energy Policy Act, restricting U.S. exports of enriched uranium. He holds a Ph.D. in political science from M.I.T. Kuperman is a former senior fellow at the U.S. Institute of Peace, and a former fellow at the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars.
