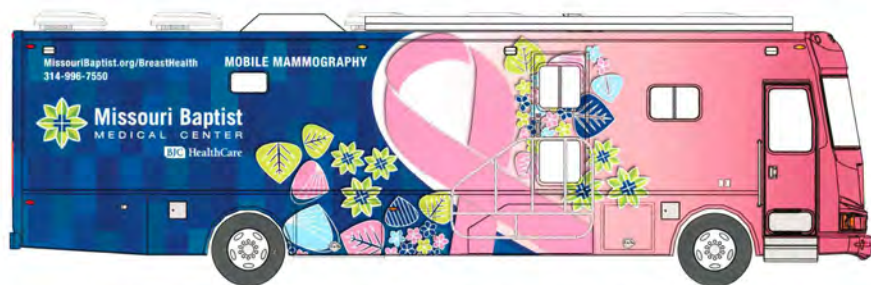

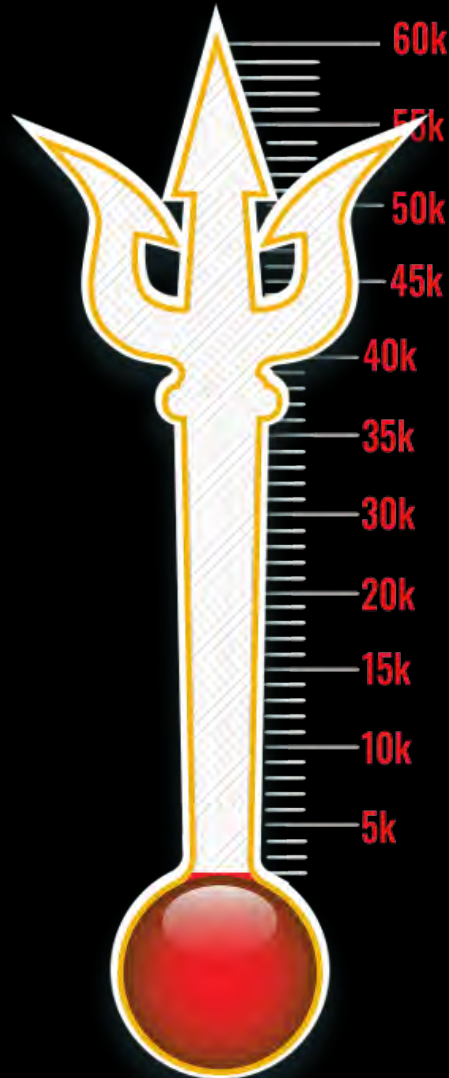

Scope

- Build out shell space on the 2nd floor of the Patient Care Center (PCC) for the College of Optometry. The remainder of coursework outside of the PCC will be conducted in Provincial House

Key Highlights

- Project substantially complete



Richter Family Welcome & Alumni Center

Scope

- Renovate the J.C. Penney South Building into a state-of-the-art Welcome & Alumni Center to enhance the campus experience for prospective students and visiting alumni
- Construct exciting community spaces, meeting rooms, and offices to support the UMSL Admissions, Alumni Engagement, and New Student Programs groups

Key Highlights

- Demolition in progress
- Currently construction phase out to bid
- Construction starts Q4 2023



TJ and Mercantile Library Renovation

Scope

- Renovate Thomas Jefferson and Mercantile libraries. Includes new student-focused spaces on the main level, a new café area, and an additional entrance on the north side of the library to improve connection with the North Campus Quad
- Relocate existing SSB computer lab to TJ Library
- Relocate library staff to a new administrative suite on the 5th floor
- Project will include an art gallery space in the Mercantile library

Key Highlights

- Final adjustments to engineering design in progress
- Construction anticipated to start Fall 2023



SSB Modernization & Expansion

Scope

- Renovate Social Sciences & Business Building (SSB). Scope includes interior renovations, improvements to building infrastructure, and a new elevator
- Relocate the College of Education and Honors College program from South Campus to the North Campus Quad

Phase 1 - Build new elevator for SSB

Phase 2 - Demolish SSB Tower

Phase 3 - Renovate SSB and construct new SSB Expansion

Key Highlights

- Phase 1: SSB Elevator construction will start this week
- Phase 2: SSB Tower demolition will start in Spring 2024
- Phase 3: SSB Modernization & Expansion schematic design in progress



Scope

- Relocating the College of Optometry from Marillac Hall to the J.C. Penney North Building. This would include renovations to provide faculty and staff offices, classrooms, study and breakout rooms, labs, and research space

Key Highlights

- JCP North schematic design in progress
- Exploring south campus dining options



Scope

- Consolidate music and fine arts to the Arts & Administration Building on the North Campus. Includes interior renovation and infrastructure improvements to AAB
- Once AAB renovations are complete, the Music Building will be demolished as a separate project
- The Sculpture and Ceramics Annex is not in the scope of this project

Key Highlights

- Bid in progress for selective demolition and data closet relocation
- Design development for the remaining design is in progress and will complete by end of year
- Construction scheduled to start Spring 2024



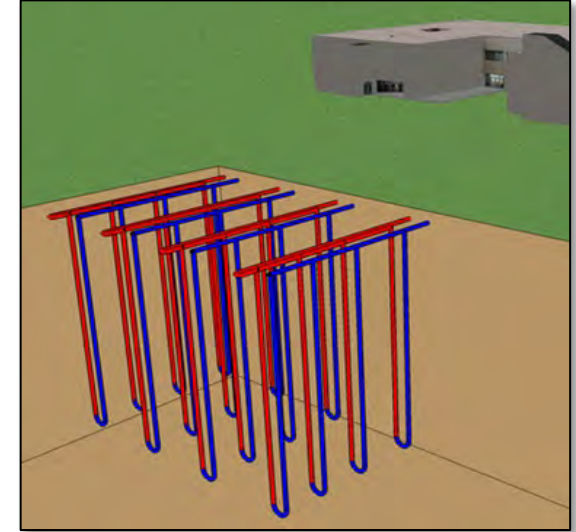
Central Utility Plant – North Campus

Scope

- UMSL is partnering with a highly capable engineering firm to complete a study/concept design for a central utility plant located on the North Campus
- Goals of this project:
 - Sustainability
 - Improved efficiency of building systems
 - Reduced operating and maintenance costs
 - Replace end-of-life equipment
 - Introduce a geothermal system to UMSL's campus

Key Highlights

- Study phase 70% complete
- Building utility metering in progress



Demo Buildings

Scope

- Selective demolition of buildings on UMSL's Campus in alignment with the 2021 Campus Master Plan and the overall vision of UMSL's physical campus
- Removes millions in deferred maintenance to improve UMSL's operating costs
- Approximately 232,000 sqft will be demolished as part of the campus consolidation

Key Highlights

- Sassin Building & Post Office demolition complete
- SSB Tower demo will start Spring 2024

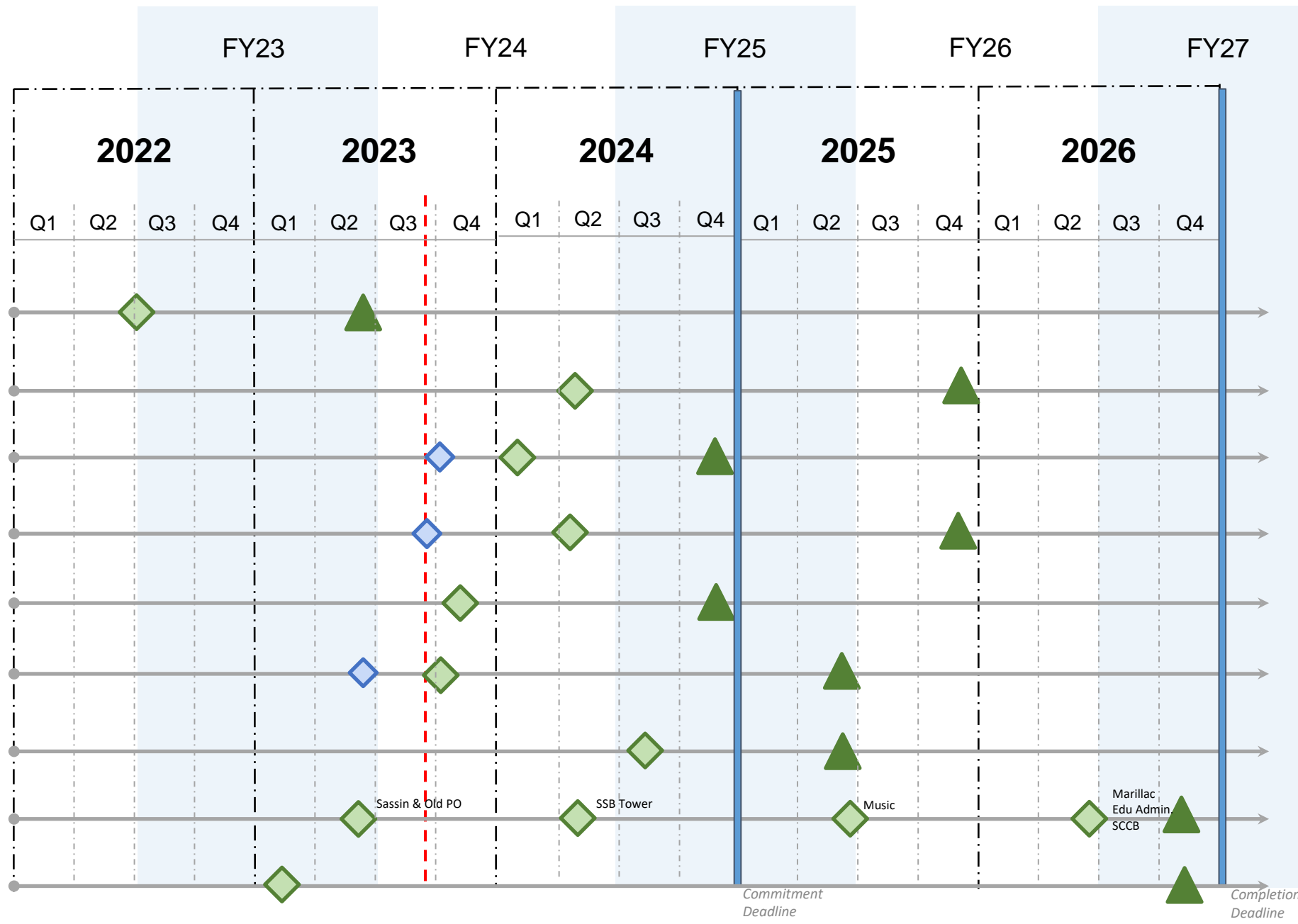
