The University of Missouri–St. Louis (UMSL) is designated as a National Center of Academic Excellence in Cyber Defense Education (CAE-CD) by the National Security Agency. UMSL was the first 4-Year academic institution in the St. Louis region to earn this rare and prestigious distinction.

The CAE-CD designation is the gold standard for the quality of a cybersecurity program and qualifies UMSL's students for cybersecurity positions in the government and private sectors. It places UMSL in an elite group of institutions to have access to cybersecurity scholarships, grants for infrastructure development, and the authorization to use the official National Security Agency and Department of Homeland Security seals on its program materials.

UMSL offers BS and MS degrees, undergraduate and graduate certificates, and an undergraduate minor in cybersecurity which all incorporate innovative lab exercises in ethical hacking and cyber defense. These programs are multidisciplinary and draw on the strengths of the Department of Information Systems and Technology in the College of Business Administration and Department of Computer Science in the College of Arts and Sciences.

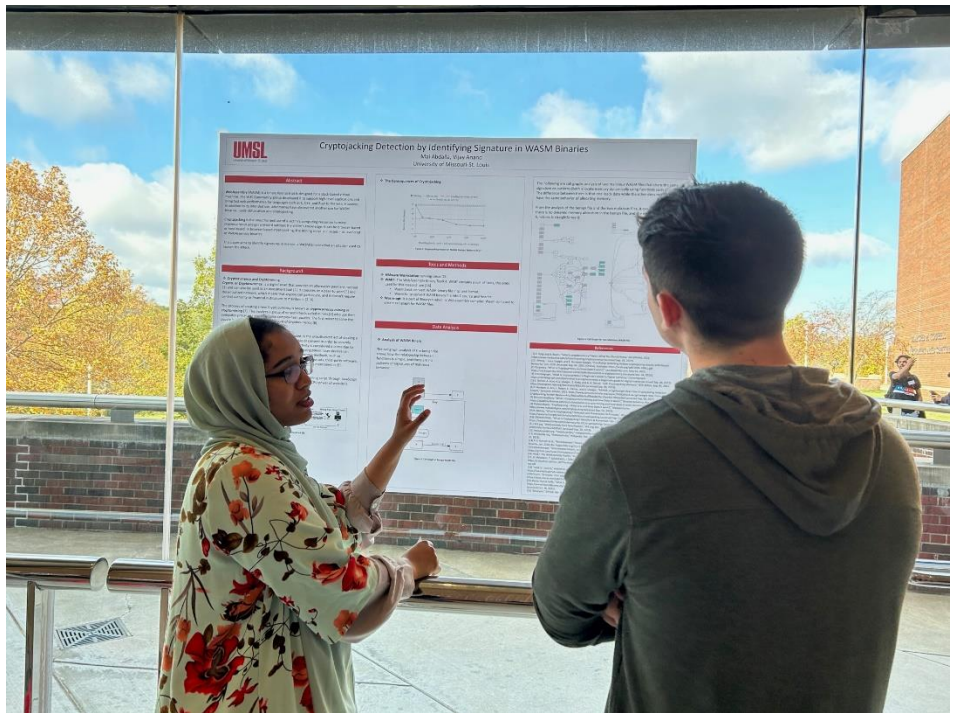
