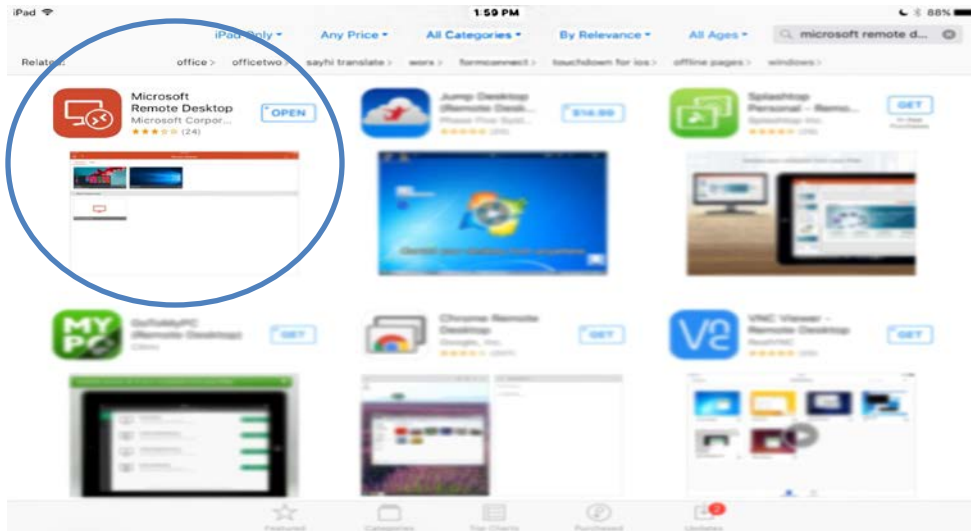
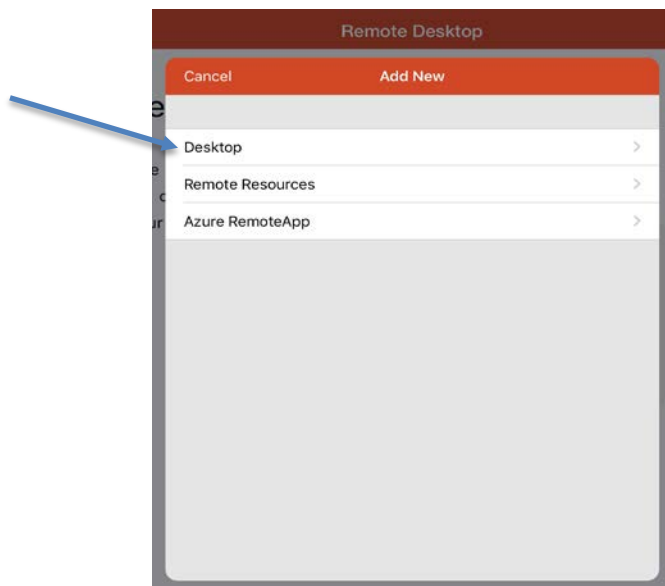


Configuring the Remote Desktop Client on Apple IOS (iPad or iPhone)


1. Download "Microsoft Remote Desktop" from the App Store



2. Launch Microsoft Remote Desktop App.
3. Click on the + on the top right of the screen to add a profile and select the "Desktop" option.




- Remember to type the fully qualified name for the computer such as **computername.stl.umsl.edu**. Click Done. Under User account add your sso id in either format: **ssoid@stl.umsl.edu** or **umsl-users\ssoid** and type your password.
