

Accessibility Guide

Updated February 2026

This guide is designed to help you plan your visit to the Touhill Performing Arts Center by providing information on accessible parking and helping you find the best option for your needs. The map visually shows the locations of our parking lots. Below, you'll find details on the number of accessible parking spaces available in each lot, as well as their distance from the building.

Parking Lots

CLOSEST TO MAIN ENTRANCE

Lot E: 19 accessible parking spots, up to 223 yards from the Main Entrance.

Lot F: 5 accessible parking spots, 185 yards from the Main Entrance.

MGN: 9 accessible parking spots, 338 yards from the Main Entrance.

CLOSEST TO LEE ENTRANCE

Upper Lot K: 4 accessible parking spots, 233 yards from the Lee Entrance.

Lot L: 1 accessible parking spots, 250 yards from the Lee Entrance.

CLOSEST TO TERRACE ENTRANCE

Lower Lot K: No accessible parking spots, 148 yards from the Terrace Entrance.

Lot N: 3 accessible parking spots, 309 yards from the Terrace Entrance (steep incline).

Lot I: No accessible parking spots, 250 yards from the Terrace Entrance (steep incline).

Notes

- The East side of the building, including the Main Entrance, is the recommended area for parking and entry.
- There is no connector road between the east and west sides of campus; you will need to exit campus and re-enter to access the opposite side.
- The MGN is the preferred parking location for the Touhill. However, you may park in the lots and garages around the Touhill without a permit on weekends and after 5:00 p.m. on weekdays.
- Accessible parking spaces can fill up quickly. Please contact the Ticket Office at 314-516-4949 for detailed information and assistance for guests with mobility needs.
- Circle drop-off is available at both the West and East entrances. No parking is permitted in the drop-off area.
