

Accessibility Guide

Updated February 2026

This guide provides information about interior accessibility features at the Touhill Performing Arts Center and helps visitors navigate the building. The map highlights accessible areas, including restrooms, elevators, entrances, and approximate distances between key locations.

ENTRANCES

Main Entrance, Upper Level
Lee Entrance, Upper Level
Terrace Entrance, Lower Level

TICKET OFFICE

The Ticket Office is located in the Main Entrance, upper level and serves as a central starting point for navigating the building.

DISTANCES FROM THE TICKET OFFICE

Lee Theater (upper level): approximately 120 yards from the Ticket Office.
Dress Circle Doors (upper level) : approximately 82 yards from the Ticket Office.
Parterre Doors (lower level): approximately 95 yards from the Ticket Office.

ELEVATORS

There are two elevators available for public use:
Elevator #1 provides access to both the lobby level and Anheuser-Busch Theater seating levels. Located near Main Entrance.
Elevator #2 provides access to the lobby level only and does not provide access to the Theater. Located by Lee Entrance.

PERFORMANCE SPACES

Anheuser-Busch Performance Hall is accessible from the upper and lower lobby levels. Elevator #1 provides access to all three theater seating levels.
Lee Theater is located on the upper level and is accessible from the Lee Entrance.

RESTROOMS

Upper level: Accessible restrooms are located near the Lee Theater.
Lower Level: Accessible restrooms are located in two locations, near spiral stair case, and on the other side by grand stairs.

COURTESY WHEELCHAIRS

Courtesy wheelchairs are available near Lee and Main Entrances.
Please ask a staff member for assistance.

STAIR ACCESS

Grand Stairs are located near the Main Entrance, and spiral stairs are located near the Lee Entrance. Elevator access is available as an alternative to both stairways.
