## Financial Aid Training

The purpose of this document is to clearly articulate the training requirements for a Financial Aid Officer at University of Missouri-St. Louis (UMSL). These policies are consistent with relevant articles in Title IV of the Higher Education Act and the Department of Defense Voluntary Education Partnership Memorandum of Understanding.

## 1. Initial training

- a) Before working with students, all financial aid officers will experience a structured training program within the Financial Aid Office. Additionally, all new financial aid officers will be required to complete the FSA Basic Training Online. Training topics include:
  - Federal Student Aid overview
  - FAA Resources
  - FAFSA Process & Student Eligibility
  - Verification and Professional Judgment, Need Analysis and Satisfactory Academic Progress
  - Packaging Concepts
  - Federal Pell Grants
  - Federal Direct Loans
  - Campus-Based Aid
  - Cash Management
  - Student Departures

In addition, the following concepts are reviewed and discussed with staff:

- Providing clear and complete explanations of available financial aid
- Understanding and describing the differences between federal student loans include terms, conditions, repayment and forgiveness options
- Understanding and disclosing UMSL's Cohort Default Rate (CDR), the percentage of students who borrow and how the CDR compares to national averages
- Understanding and explaining that students have the ability to refuse or borrow less than the maximum amount allowed
- Explaining the importance of utilizing free funds and benefits before considering loans or repayable financial aid options

## 2. Continuous education

- a) Financial Aid staff will participate in weekly staff training sessions. Topic during these sessions will include: Military and veteran programs; FAFSA updates; topics identified in our annual audits; updates from Depts. of Education, Labor, Defense, and Veterans; lessons learned from financial aid conferences; and other relevant areas of need or interest.
- b) To remain "current", members of the financial aid office will attend the following conferences or meetings online:
  - Missouri Association of Student Financial Aid Personnel (MASFAP)
  - Midwest Association of Student Financial Aid Administrators (MASFAA)
  - National Association of Student Financial Aid Administrators (NASFAA)
  - Coalition of State University Aid Administrators (COSUAA)

## 3. Certification / Audits

- a) The UMSL Student Financial Services Office will be externally audited every year and the audit results will be made public as well as reported to Department of Education.
- b) For the past several years our audit (conducted by BKD Audit and Consulting) has revealed zero findings. It is the goal of this department to keep that standard.
